St. Mary's Academy is pleased to announce a continuing partnership program with the Manitoba Conservatory of Music & Arts (MCMA) for the 2025-26 school year. This partnership will deliver individual music lessons on campus for SMA students. By hosting MCMA instructors in our school, we will be able to offer the highest standard of music lessons combined with convenience for students to attend music lessons in our building. We also view this partnership as an opportunity to enhance and support our current music programming.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Individual lessons are available for:

- o Voice
- o Violin
- o Electric Guitar
- o Acoustic Guitar
- o Piano
- o Organ

Instruments will be available based on a minimum threshold of 2 students per discipline. If there is interest, other instruments may be added. Email info@mcma.ca with your request.

Lessons will be scheduled in 30-minute intervals on Tues/Wed/Thurs afternoons after school.

Lessons will begin the week of **September 8, 2025** and the last lessons will be delivered the week of **May 25, 2026.**

No lessons will be scheduled during Christmas Break, Spring Break or SMA student related events. Please refer to the lesson schedule at the bottom of the 'SMA & MCMA Individual Lesson Package'.

Lessons take place on the St. Mary's Academy campus and are delivered by the MCMA.

MCMA supports and encourages performances for students at recitals and in the community through our Music Equals program, the outreach arm of the MCMA. Registration Policies

- 1. No refunds will be issued, nor makeup lessons scheduled for classes missed by the student. An exception will be made for illness/medical reasons, with a provided doctor's note. Lessons missed by reason of teacher absence will be made-up.
- 2. **WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS:** Two (2) weeks' written notice must be provided for withdrawal from individual lessons. Tuition is payable for the duration of the two-week period whether the student attends the classes or not. Non-attendance does not constitute notice of withdrawal. Written notice must be provided to the MCMA (info@mcma.ca) as notice of withdrawal. Registration and installment fees are non-refundable.
