

On June 1, our Province moves to Phase Two of the Restoring Safe Services plan. SMA families were updated in our Friday, May 22 Communiqué with initial, key information. Today, we are sharing more details with protocols for the month of June.

## Classroom learning will remain suspended for this school year. A robust and successful remote learning plan is in motion and will continue for the remainder of this school year.

- Teacher focus for the final two weeks of school is to ensure students are completing crucial elements of their curricula.
- All learning and assessment opportunities for the current school year will end on June 17. June 17 will be the last day to submit any outstanding items to teachers.
- Students are asked to plan their time wisely for the balance of this school year to ensure they are up-to-date on all required assignments. A review of Teams and PowerSchool will be helpful to remind or inform students on areas where support is needed.

## Teachers and student support staff will be available at SMA until June 17, by appointment only.

- Teachers MAY need to meet with individual students or small groups of students for the purpose of advancing learning outcomes. This is particularly the case for students who require extra support to meet a minimum of 50% of curricular outcomes and allow for a smoother transition to next year's studies. In this event, the teacher will contact the student directly to arrange an appointment.
- Student support staff will be available at SMA, by appointment only, to meet with students. This includes resource support, personal counselling, academic advising and spiritual guidance and care.
- Students who wish to meet with a teacher or support staff are asked to contact that person directly to arrange an in-person appointment.

## **Appointments at SMA**

- Students with an appointment <u>must arrive at the Administration door</u> and present themselves to
  our receptionist. The student will complete a very brief health questionnaire to determine if entry is
  safe. The student will be met by their teacher or support staff and she/he will accompany the
  student to a classroom for their meeting. At the conclusion of the appointment, the teacher/support
  staff will walk the student back to the reception area for <u>immediate departure</u> (please ensure
  transportation has been arranged).
- Everyone on SMA's premises must adhere to the practices of physical/social distancing and frequent hand washing.
- Hand sanitizing stations are located on each floor and at entrances (includes gel, wipes and gloves).
- Students who wish to wear a mask are asked to bring their own.
- SMA continues to ensure our facility is sanitized on a regular basis.
